



Notice of Race
Star of the North - One Design Regatta
September 24 - 26th, 2010
Lake Minnetonka - Wayzata Yacht Club - Wayzata, MN

You and your crew are invited to join the Wayzata Yacht Club Capri 25, Sonar, and S2 7.9 fleets in one design racing on beautiful Lake Minnetonka. We are planning great one design racing and great parties.

Rules

- The Wayzata Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority.
- The races will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto.
- Each fleet shall employ all class rules, except as specifically modified by the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions will take precedence in case of conflict.
- The Capri 25 Class will be restricted to ISAF group one sailors (no professionals onboard). The other classes are open to all sailors.
- There will be two divisions of the Sonar Class. The Sonar Class Association Appendix B - Alternate Rules shall apply to the non-spinnaker division.

Eligibility

This event is open to all boats of the Capri 25, Sonar and S2 7.9 classes that:

- meet the measurement criteria of their class.
- are covered by paid up marine liability insurance of at least \$300,000.
- Have at least one member of their crew as a paid member of US Sailing.
- Capri 25s and Sonars must be a paid member of their respective WYC Fleets. This requirement is waived for non-WYC boats.
- S2 7.9s must be paid members of the S2 7.9 National Class Association and display the appropriate decal on their boat.

Measurement

All boats must conform to the measurement rules of their One Design Class Association or must receive a written waiver from their respective regatta fleet representative. A boat may be required to submit to an inspection / measurement for any reason at any time while not racing. For any item in question, measurement will be available at registration. It is the intent of the organizing authority to waive non-compliant measurements on boats from outside the Wayzata Yacht Club where boat speed is not substantially affected. Out of town boats are asked to petition the OA waivers for known deviations from the rules prior to the regatta in order to avoid disappointment at registration.



Entry Forms and Fees

Entry forms are available online at www.wyc.org/star/ . The entry fee is \$120 if paid by September 18, 2010. After September 18, the fee will be \$150.00.

Each registration will include 4 tickets to Saturday dinner. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased for \$10.00.

Lunches are not provided. Lunches may be ordered online for \$8 each. Deadline for ordering lunches is September 22.

Tickets are not required for other meals.

Upon request, we will attempt to arrange housing for out-of-town visitors in private homes.

5:45 PM – Warning for Tune-up Race (Race 4 of WYC M Series). All visiting regatta participants are invited to compete.

- **Friday 9/24**

7:30 – 9:00 AM - Registration, continental breakfast.

8:30 AM - Skipper meeting.

10:00 AM – Warning signal for first race. Up to 4 races back to back. Lunch on the water. Buoy courses.

4:30 PM - Social hour & refreshments, followed by dinner and live music.

- **Saturday 9/25**

7:30 – 9:00 AM - Continental breakfast.

10:00 AM – Warning signal for first race. Up to 4 races back to back. Lunch on the water. 1 race may be a medium distance random course race, others are buoy courses

4:30 PM - Social hour & refreshments, followed by dinner and “the band”. A raffle will be part of the evening’s activities.

- **Sunday 9/26**

10:00AM - Warning signal for first race. Up to 2 races back to back, buoy courses. No warning after approximately 12:30 PM.

2:00 PM - Refreshments, award ceremony, and crane out.



Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, RRS Appendix A will be used. One race is required to be completed to constitute a series. If five or more races are completed, each yacht's worst score will be excluded.

Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

Trophies

Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 5th place all classes, except the Sonar non-spinnaker division. Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 3rd place in the Sonar non-spinnaker division.
